

# TRAFFIC CONTROLLER FOR CATEGORY 1 ROADS (TC1) STUDENT JOURNEY

## 1. Enrol in your Course

Book your course online or by calling our friendly customer service team and provide a copy of your white card (or soft).

## 2. Attend 2 Day of Training + Post Course Assessment

You will receive 2 full days of training involving theory & practical plus up to 1/2 a day for assessment.

## 3. TC Practical Experience

After completing at least 20 hours of free work placement (or through your existing employer) you can be assessed for your VicRoads TC1 Card.

## 4. Receive your credentials

After attending the course and completing the practical requirements, you will receive a VicRoads Card for TC1 and a Statement of Attainment for the skill set:
